Sheri is a member of the Youth for Easter Seals (Y.E.S.). Dancers of Columbus, Ohio, whose Wheelchair Exhibitions drew raves at the National Square Dance Conventions in both Detroit and Louisville. Sheri's rendition of "Coal Miner's Daughter" at Louisville brought standing ovations. For Al, it was love at first sound. Their recording, PR 1068, with Al doing the hash and Sheri the vocal, will be available early this year.

Now the story of Sheri is: She is 19 years old, suffers from Arthritis and is blind, confined to a wheelchair. She is one of the Wheelchair Dancers.

The problem is — she is going to have two operations soon, one of which will take her voice which hopefully may be restored later. The second will relieve pressure on her heart and lungs. 





#### F.D.V.S. AND R.D. MEETING PRODUCTIVE - LENGTHY

Invariably the Delaware Valley Federation meetings seem to produce discussion of one magnitude or antoher sometimes constructive, but always invigorating. Such was true of the first meeting of the New Year, January 12th.

The usual District reports were concise, pointing the current activities of each.

Standing Committee chairmen reports were available detailing specific data as

Education — President's Ball has more than 300 "intentions to prarticipate."

Membership — Total to date 3042. Nominating — Current officers are eligible and have indicated intention to run a second term — election dance April 15.

23rd Convention — 555 Registrations to date - All Callers and Cuers under contract

**Baltimore National Convention** 12,750 Registrations to date — expect 25 to 27 thousand. Spotters needed for June 29; only 26 signed of the 400 needed.

Old Business - Produced the invigorating discussions mentioned above. Specific items included:

Wildwood weekend Dance sponsored by Federation, practically a certainty

complete details at a later date.

Survey by Districts on interest in Philadelphia National sponsoring a Convention in 1990 indicated mixture of ayes and nays.

Revised version of Constitution and By-Laws produced "fire works"  $-2\frac{1}{2}$  hours of heated debate — a few disagreements and a majority of approvals - general evaluation, a good job — completed version will be presented for adoption at the Annual Meeting on April 15.

New Business was tabled for later consideration due to the late hour — a motion for adjournment, at 11:40 was hearty and unanimous.

Next meeting will be March 8 at the Philadelphia Centre Hotel.






