## FEDERATION UPDATE

Ethel \& Harry Smith, Publicity (D.V.S. \& R.D. Federation)

Around 60 people filled the meeting room at the Dunfey City Line Hotel in Philadelphia on March 12, 1987, for the Board Meeting of the Federation of Delaware Valley Square and Ffound Dancers.

The Federation's 1987 membership totaled 3,015 which is an increase of 420 over last year.

Clayton Kerns reported that his committee had selected a proposed General Chairman for the 1992 National Conven-
tion in Philadelphia (if they become the successful bidders at the 1988 National Convention in Aneheim). After a unanimous vote of the Federation's Board of Directors, it was voted that Bill \& Doris Manuel be elected as the Convention's Chairmen. There is a great deal of work involved for Bill \& Doris in preparing the bid process for the 1992 Convention and we wish them great success. However, this will not succeed without the support of a great many dancers.

Each District will receive a budget of $\$ 600.00$ for the Free Summer Dance expenses. They are reminded to inform their callers to keep to the basic mainstream (1-68) level and their cuers to keep to the easy level.

It was voted that the Federation advance an amount of $\$ 1,000.00$ to the Golden Nugget Cloggers for their 1988 trip to Russia and Germany in the Youth Ámbassador Exchange Program. Hopefully, with our help they will be able to raise enough funds for the trip.

It was with great sadness that the Fed-

eration received the withdrawl of nominee Doug Vollmer (Penn-Jersey District) for Federation President because of the recent death of his wife Ethel. If we can not find another Penn-Jersey District candidate it will also mean the withdrawl of nominee Merle Plummer for Secretary. As it is necessary for the President and Secretary to live in close proximity because of the necessity for a close working relationship. All Federation members regret the loss of Ethel Vollmer.

It was voted that the Federation ioan the Bucks Trenton District $\$ 500,00$ to help them once again get started. This will become effective in September, 1987.

It was learned that heavy construction will begin in the Dunfey City Line Hotel during the summer to turn it into an office complex. This was shocking news to the Convention Committee as September's Convention had to be moved. The new location is the Biandywine Hotel a Resort in Downingtown, PA.
