## SEWING WITH RUTH McLAY

Perhaps you would like to add a pocket to your dress or skirt without changing the style. By opening the side seams of your skirt, it can easily be done. Remember, it's very important that you use the same material that your skirt is made of.

Measure down from the waistline $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ at the side seam (adjust according to your height or whatever is comfortable for you) and mark it. Cut out 2 pieces of material for the pocket with right sides together. Stitch around the pocket all but the extension area. Place the pocket extension in the seam allowance of the skirt (starting at the above measured point) with right sides together (pointed end of the pocket towards the waist) and stitch each side of the pocket opening close to the side seamline (make sure right sides are together). Pin the skirt seam together, lining up the pocket neatly. Stitch down from (continued on page 25)

the waist and fasten off with a back tack and end at the upper end of the pocket opening. Stitch up the seamline to the lower end of the pocket opening and fasten off with a back tack. Fold the pocket towards the front of the skirt and press evenly, matching the seamline.

If you do not have a pocket pattern, experiment with a piece of tissue paper. Make an elongated heart shape about $10^{\prime \prime}$ long and 6 " at the widest part of the heart shape. Fold the heart in half lengthwise and cut in half along the fold line (discard one half) then add a $3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ extension from the pointy end up the straight edge for about $6^{\prime \prime}$. Using this pattern, cut out 2 pieces of material for each pocket with the right sides together. Stitch around the pocket excluding the extension area (proceed as stated above).

No one will ever know you have a pocket until you put your hand in it. You may add a pocket to each side of the skirt if you so desire. If you have already made your garment, it is so easy to open the side seams and put in the pocket. Try it sometime, you will surprise yourself.
