AN OPEN COMMUNIQUE TO CALLERLAB

March 16, 2018

Dear CALLERLAB Executives:

I wish to call attention to a situation I have tolerated for decades, but which is becoming more and more intolerable as I develop arthritis in my hands. My concern is the way square dancers hold hands. I have danced at thousands of local dances in multiple states, danced at State conventions in a few states, and two National Conventions. I have observed that hand squeezing is wide spread and very common. I estimate that well over 95 percent of dancers do it. This group includes callers, instructors, and spouses of callers and instructors. *Following is my position.*

Square dancing should be groups of dancers cooperatively working together to execute the calls correctly and have a good time. This means that the people next to a dancer should be able to lead/ guide that dancer if needed. On the other hand, the dancer being provided this lead/guidance must be free and able not to accept it. This can be done by simply dropping the hand hold. However, this can't be done if the dancer's hand is being squeezed. What do I mean by squeezed? The human hand has two sets of opposing sides. The palm and back of the hand is one set, the side with the thumb and the side with the little finger is the other. If opposing sides of a hand are being touched at the same time, that hand is being squeezed. This is independent of the force being applied. The force applied determines how hard the hand is being squeezed.

What is wrong with hand squeezing?

For people with arthritis it can be painful. This is something that is hard to appreciate until it happens to you. Worrying "How much is the person approaching me going to hurt me this time?" certainly detracts from the joy of square dancing. I wonder how many dancers have guit because of this.

The person whose hand is being squeezed is reduced to a slave. They are under the control of the person squeezing their hand and can't execute the next call until their hand is released or they "revolt" and forcibly remove their hand.

The person squeezing the hand can force the other person to do things they don't want to do. Having your hand or arm twisted is great motivation. A single under the arm turn without releasing the hand will result in twisted

wrists. A second turn would result in sprained if not broken wrists.

Are there possible solutions?

One is to touch hands palm to palm with the fingers slightly hooked (curved) to touch either the thumb or little finger side of the other's hand. The fingers should not be hooked so much that they wrap around the hand to touch the back or the hand and <u>most importantly, the thumb</u> should be held out of the way so that it touches nothing. This way, two adjacent sides of the hand are being touched at the same time and not two opposite sides and thus the hand is not being squeezed. As long as the hands are thus interlocked, a dancer can easily lead/guide an adjacent dancer if that dancer wants to accept it. The hand hold can easily be broken by either dancer at any time by simply straightening the fingers and/or moving the hand.

Anything else?

Now that the parts of the hand to be touched have been determined, the question of how to position the hands remains. In my experience, a common convention is for men to hold their hands palms up and ladies palms down. This convention doesn't work when same sexes are side by side. One solution is for every one to hold their right hand palm up and left hand palm down. Now no one will have to change their hand orientation regardless of the order of the sexes in the formation. There is another advantage of this hand orientation. Imagine standard facing lines. Let's focus on the man in the center of one of the lines. That man is a Beau with respect to his partner, but at the same time is is a Bell if the centers are active. This convention would give dancers another way to determine if they are Bell or Beau with respect to other dancers. If their hand on the side of the other dancer is palm down, than they are a Bell with respect to that dancer. If their hand on the side of the other dancer is palm up, than they are a Beau with respect to that dancer.

I ask that CALLERLAB take these things into consideration and develop guidelines/rules for hand holding. These guidelines/rules should be the very first thing taught at the very first lesson of every beginner class.

Note: Most of these ideas are not originally mine, but are the result of my experience and discussions with other dancers.

Cost vs. Benefits

Recently, I heard someone indicate how expensive it was to square dance. I think in part they were concerned about the price of our special clothing. I decided to explore what it costs for some of my other activities for comparison.

<u>I golf</u>. You need golf clubs, balls, tees, special shoes, a hat and fees to the golf course. On average it costs between \$20 and \$40 for 4 ½ hours of golfing. You also need special shoes and shirts with collars as well as pants or shorts with pockets. It is good exercise, requires some concentration and skill, lessons help and the social aspect is minimal with interactions between 1 and 4 people.

<u>I bowl.</u> You need a bowling ball, special shoes and comfortable clothes. The cost is \$8.00 to \$20.00 depending on fees at the lanes and if you are in league for about 2 hours exercise per week. It is good exercises, requires some concentration and skill and lessons do help. The social aspect involves mainly people on your team and within your league.

<u>I fish</u>. You need a fishing rod, hooks, bait, a hat, special licenses and since I have a boat I also need a boat license, trailer license, and gas for the boat, The costs add up, but after the initial investment it is a matter of time and patience. Exercise is minimal, patience a must. And remember it is calling fishing not

catching. Do you socialize with the fish?

<u>I read.</u> Well you need good lighting, a comfortable chair, good glasses, and lots of reading material. This varies in price depending on where you get your books and if you have chosen to have a nook. Exercise is minimal, requires mental concentration and there is almost no social interaction.

<u>So what about square dancing?</u> Yes, we need some special clothes, as do most other activities, and comfortable shoes. The cost of this clothing depends upon your choice since often gently used clothing is available within our clubs or federation. The cost per evening ranges between \$4 and \$8 for 2 ½ to 3 hours of great exercises. It also requires mental concentration and has great social appeal since you need at least eight dancers. We can then vary squares we dance within as well as clubs and locations. The same lessons help us dance in all these locations.

So it seems that to get the most physical, mental and social benefits for the least cost, square dancing is the way to go. So find yourself some square dancing clothes and comfortable shoes and we will see you in a square somewhere.
