## FOOTE NOTES

### CHANGING TIMES: THE FUTURE OF YELLOW ROCK

by Ed Foote (reprinted from American Square Dance Magazine) In recent years we have seen a sharp rise in sexual harassment issues in the news, including confidential agreements, high profile trials, and resignations of people in prominent positions. What is and is not sexual harassment is a subject of widespread debate.

Yellow Rock, including variations with other names, has been part of the square dance activity for over 50 years. This name for hugging was invented by a caller calling at Yellow Rock Barn outside of Kansas City, MO. For decades people considered Yellow Rock harmless fun and a way to increase friendliness in square dancing. But in these changing times of sexual harassment focus, it may be time to take another look at Yellow Rock.

The Board of Governors (25 callers) of CALLERLAB did so at a recent annual convention, where considerable time was devoted to a discussion of the issue. Male members, who comprise a majority of the Board, were genuinely concerned about whether they could be accused of sexual harassment if they called Yellow Rock. In addition, they worried whether they could be accused if they themselves gave someone a Yellow Rock.

Female members of the Board described their experiences of appropriate and inappropriate Yellow Rocks that they had received over the years. It quickly became clear that there is a fine line between appropriate and inappropriate hugging, and that this line is different for each person - both the giver and the receiver of the Yellow Rock.

Male callers were concerned that they might be reported to CALLERLAB for an ethics violation if they call Yellow Rock, even though there is currently nothing specific on this topic in the CALLERLAB Code of Ethics. They were also concerned they might be reported if they gave a Yellow Rock to someone -- reported either by the person who received the Yellow Rock or by someone viewing the action from across the room.

**More on Yellow Rock.** It was suggested that callers take a poll of their home clubs, to see if people liked Yellow Rock. But it was quickly noted that unless this was a secret ballot, no one would vote against it because such a stand could cause embar *Continued on page 10*

## **Visitation Program**

The 2018-19 Visitation season is over with Happy-Go-Lucky Squares earning clear victories in all categories. They cleared last year's winners, Friendly Squares by three in Complete Rounds, by eight in total visits, by twelve in total points and by thirty total visitors. They also earned \$35.00 more cash.

Of nineteen different visitors, ten won dangles for five or more visits. Five of their members had over ten visits and of those, Fran Reynolds (23), George Cochran (21) and Jean Napiecek (21) had over twenty. Pete Reynolds fell just one short of a score with 19.

Friendly had twenty different dancers with visits and earned 14 dangles but there are no club awards for that.

If there was an award for travel, Mountainview Squares would win that easily. While other clubs had to travel to Blairsville once per round, they had to go *from* there for each visitation. Kudos to Mountainview.

rassment and be perceived as unfriendly. Also, if just one person voted against Yellow Rock, that person might possibly claim sexual harassment in the future, based on that person's definition of what is appropriate.

One caller said he only calls Yellow Rock with the original partner. This was fine decades ago, when most couples were married. But he recognized that in this day of so many singles dancing with various people during a dance, this is probably no longer appropriate.

The story was told of a well-known caller who started a large beginners class. This caller recognized that the personal space of new dancers was much larger than those who have danced a long time, so he intentionally never showed Yellow Rock until later in class. This caller had to miss the third night of class, and the replacement caller showed Yellow Rock. The next week half the class had quit, because their personal space had been invaded in a manner unacceptable to them.

**Bottom line.** The Board took no vote on this issue, and callers are free to call Yellow Rock as they wish. But many callers on the Board said they had already stopped calling Yellow Rock, and others said they planned to do so. They all agreed it was just a no-win situation for them.

So, while Yellow Rock will not be going away, it is likely to be used far less in the future. When you notice that the use of Yellow Rock is in decline, remember the observations made here and you will know the reason.

**A note to callers.** At the meeting, male callers asked the female callers what to do if a woman walks up to you with arms outstretched, obviously wanting a Yellow Rock. This can happen at any time during a dance, and especially in a "thank you line" at the end of a dance. If the male caller steps forward too far (in the mind of the woman), it could be considered an aggressive move. But if he does not move at all, this could be considered unfriendly. What to do?

Answer from the female callers: The male caller should turn his body sideways 90 degrees - this will cause the woman to turn her body to face the same direction as the man. Then the man puts his arm around the woman's back and gives a half hug. The female callers said this was a perfect solution.

Likewise, if a male approaches a female caller with arms outstretched, the female caller can turn sideways 90 degrees and give a half hug. This keeps her in control of the situation.

## In Memory of Bill Flick, a Great Friend Loved by Many and Missed by All

It is with mixed emotions that Tony & I sit down to write this article. It is an extreme honor to have been considered among Bill's closest friends and to have the opportunity to share with you the beautiful person he was as demonstrated throughout his life of 87 years. On the other hand it is very difficult as every word has been written through windows of tears and sad hearts.

Love and Concern for Others

Bill's love and compassion for children (and those who work with them) can be seen in his years spent as an elementary teacher and building principal. He began his teaching career at age 20 when he taught 5<sup>th</sup> & 6<sup>th</sup> grade students and continued until his retirement as Principal at Linwood Elementary in 1986. His impact on the students was a lasting one as he was sharing with us just a couple of months ago about running into one of his former students. This man was telling Bill what a positive influence he had on his life, a fact that was quite humbling to our dear friend. Through his church, Swarthmore United Methodist Church, Bill took advantage of the many opportunities to serve others. One such example is when he routinely served meals to the homeless through the ministry of Grace Café. We recall one story when the winter weather was raging and yet Bill, difficult though it was, got to the Café to serve a hot meal to those in need. This past week we have received countless emails from fellow square dancers detailing how Bill had been so gracious and concerned for them. How he was there to offer encouragement and support no matter what the situation. Personally, Bill has been a tremendous help and encouragement to us as we served together on many square dance committees. He knew how to push us just enough to be our best just as he was demonstrating his very best. We are sure Bill would be both amazed and humbled if he knew just how great of an impact he had on so many people.

#### **Extreme Dedication and Devotion**

As a loving husband and father, Bill was a shining star of dedication and devotion. He and his late wife, Joan, spent many days traveling in their RV as they visited and danced in all 50 states. They even danced in Seville, Spain at the Universal Exposition in 1992. Bill and his daughter, Penni, were avid Phillies fans and have been home game season ticket holders for many years, a precious memory of a passionate father. Let's talk about dedication. Bill was a 60 year member of the Aston Twp. Lions Club where he received the Melvin Jones Award. He was also a member of the Swarthmore United Methodist Church for 48 years where he always sang in the choir, even up until his passing. He spent countless hours devoted to his passion of square dancing. He and Joan, besides traveling the country and to Spain, held offices in every level of square dance organizations from his local club, Club Sashay, to regional and state offices, National Convention committees, and the United Square Dancers of America. He and Joan were chairmen of Pennsylvania's first state convention and he attended all 23 past PA state conventions, being on most of the convention committees. He also attended National Conventions for over 20 years, serving as Vice-Chairman for Panels at Baltimore, MD in 2000. Also at the national level, he has been very active in the United Square Dancers of America, USDA. In this organization he and his late wife, Joan, served as National President for two years and Eastern Vice-President for three years. Later he also served as Eastern Vice-President for another three years, Treasurer for six years, and Parliamentarian for four years as well as chairing four other committees. In June 2017 he was honored with a service medal representing his 25 years of service in the United Square Dancers of America. At this same time the USDA Board of Directors bestowed the title of HONORARY MEMBERS upon both Bill and Joan. To quote the editor of the USDA News, Larry Dunkel, "Whatever Bill's position, he gave it his all. He had a 'passion' to see that it was done right which probably explains why he was trusted with so many different areas of responsibility." USDA News Volume XXX Issue 3 Jul-Sept 2018

#### **Did You Know?**

Bill was a member of his high school marching band.

- Bill loved eagles and collected them in many different types of media.
- Bill was a member of the West Chester Community Choir.
- Bill sang barber shop choir music.
- As a member of the community choir, Bill sang the National Anthem at the several Phillies and Blue Rock (minor league) games.
- Bill enjoyed leading the crowd in the correct recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance with emphasis on the phrase "One nation under God" with no pause.
- Bill enjoyed doing needlepoint and made kneeling pillows depicting his church's *logo*.
- Bill designed and made the needlepoint picture of the eagle shown here. It took him 11 months to complete. He saw the picture and used graph paper to count each stitch and create the needlepoint pattern.

Bill, you have been loved by so many and will be missed by all. You have left very big shoes to fill, but with your example to follow many will be trying to follow your footsteps.

It seems like I have known Bill forever, but it has only been since August 19, 1994. That was the first day of the 1<sup>st</sup> Annual Pennsylvania Square and Round Dance Convention at Camp Hill, PA. Bill and Joan Flick were the General Chairman of the Convention. After that there were 22 other annual conventions and Bill served on the Convention Committee for 15 additional conventions (including a repeat as the General Chairman for the 12<sup>th</sup> Convention in 2005) and attended many more as a dancer. We worked together many times over the years and I always enjoyed being around him with his sense of humor and optimistic attitude. He was an avid fan of Square Dancing and served at all levels of participation at the club, state and national levels. opportunity to serve our dance community along with all of his other interest in his church and family. Bill, may God keep you safe in his






