FOOTE NOTES

SECRET HINTS FOR DANCING LOAD THE BOAT

If Load the Boat is going to break down, it will be due to the centers. The reason is that the initial Pass Thru in the center is too big. This happens because the dancers take two full steps after passing shoulders in the Pass Thru.

The result is the center box is now so big that people lose their orientation, which causes the square to break down. Or, if the square does not break down, it takes too long to finish the call, which means the square is now behind the other squares on the floor.

SECRET HINT. The centers Pass Thru must be VERY SHORT. In other words, after the centers pass right shoulders in doing the initial Pass Thru, they must IMMEDIATELY turn their back on the flagpole center of the square.

As a caller, how do I get them to do this? By painting a visual picture of what should happen. I say these specific words: "You must stay very close to the person with whom you are doing the Pass Thru. This means the material on your sleeve should be in constant contact with the material on the other person 's sleeve - during the 'turn out' part and also during the Partner Trade."

I also tell them that they are too far apart if any daylight can be seen between their shoulder and the other person's shoulder during the "turn out" and the Partner Trade."

Then, as a joke, but also to paint the visual picture, I say: "Think of it as a nohands Yellow Rock." Dancers will often treat this as a fun thing and start bumping each other intentionally, but it means they have gotten the idea,

I have found that these 3 visual pictures: material on the sleeves, no daylight and the Yellow Rock, get the job done.

If you are a dancer helping out a Plus class, and the caller does not emphasize this idea of being very close in the center, be sure and tell people what has been mentioned here. You will be helping them a great deal.

NOTE: Sometimes the centers, after the initial Pass Thru, will face in (instead of out) and then slide sideways. This puts them in the correct position, but they have made 2 mistakes to get there. I have seen this done by people who have been dancing for years.

For some reason, it is always the girls who do this, never the boys. Perhaps it is a psychological thing that girls do not want to turn their back on someone.

If a person is doing this, they need to be corrected right away, because if they keep doing this for a long time it will be very difficult for them to break the habit later. If they encounter a caller at a workshop who starts fractionalizing the center part, they will break down the square. It also means that anyone seeing them dance this way will think they are a poor dancer.

If you a e a dancer helping out at a Plus class, and you see someone doing this, be sure to say something to that person during the break. The action is so subtle that the caller may miss seeing it while calling.

WHAT TO TELL THE OUTSIDES. They have the easy part - just pass 3 people and face in. The only thing they may do wrong is go too slow. If this happens, tell them to speed up.

Square Dancer Profile: Louise Stewart

Louise Stewart and her husband, Elmer were introduced to square dancing by her nephew, David Valenti. David was learning square dance calling, and got the family to try dancing out on the patio.



Elmer loved "that cowboy music." When David told them that square dance lessons were starting in September of 1978, they cleared their calendar to attend lessons. Not only did they attend Village Stomper's lessons with Wade Johnson, they also went to Wade's lessons for the Buttons and Bows club, and Jack Hague's classes for Friendly Squares as well. With three lessons a week, the Stewarts were learning fast. But their learning was interrupted by a six-week Airstream caravan to Mexico in the winter, which had already been planned. Upon their return, they worked hard to get caught up with the other dance students, and graduated as Plus Dancers in May of 1979. Louise says that they never stopped dancing after that. 'We danced every night of the week and sometimes twice a day." Two years later they began Advanced Square Dancing lessons with Jack Hague, an excellent but demanding teacher. They then danced with his Invitationonly Advanced Club, the Cloverleaf Squares. Louise went to those dances for her husband, but she found it very stressful because Jack Hague didn't hesitate to embarrass you if you made a mistake.

Dancing was enormously popular back in the 1970's. Friendly Squares had ten squares of students at lessons, not counting the angels. 20 squares were on the floor at regular Friendly Squares dances, which cost \$2.50 per person.

Elmer and Louise owned a landscaping and lawn care business, and Louise kept the books. They had two sons, Ron and Jim. Jimmy also got into square

dancing, and founded the Golden Triangle singles square dance club. Louise has five grandchildren and nine great-grandchildren. Louise has been providing childcare for her granddaughter Beth's children since they were born. The oldest, Stewart, christened Louise "Weezie," because "Grandma" was too hard to say. Now everyone calls her Weezie, including all her neighbors in Carnegie.

The Stewarts not only danced locally, but attended various dance festivals and conventions. They started going to the March WASCA festival in 1980, and attended every year until 1997. Although they

were registered for the dance that year, Elmer died in February and didn't get to go. He had been working for three years to get Ron Libby, one of their favorite national callers, to come to Friendly Squares. Libby finally came in April of 1997, but Elmer didn't get to see the 30 squares that turned out for that dance.

After Elmer's passing, Louise didn't go back to dancing right away. But Friendly Square club members Jack and Anna Marie Merhaut insisted that she get back to dancing. They picked her up every Sunday to take her to Friendly Squares' dances. 21 years later, at age 96, Louise is still a faithful dancer at Friendly Squares. She bakes cakes to bring for refreshments, schedules dances and callers, and always has yellow rocks for club members and visitors alike.
