*CALLERLAB, an international organization of over 3,000 square dance callers, held its first convention in 1974. However, the roots of CALLERLAB go back to the mid 1960's. CALLERLAB people have been working in many ways to help square dancing since then. To help everyone understand CALLERLAB and what it is doing, we offer this list of accomplishments.

More than 20 years ago, CALLERLAB members developed dance programs that have been accepted world wide. These dance programs let you go anywhere in the world and dance.

CALLERLAB members documented and negotiated international agreement on the definition of all the calls we use. For the first time ever, calls were taught the same way in California as they were in New England - or old England, Germany, and everywhere else.

CALLERLAB has printed and published thousands of pages of publications to help callers and dancers. These publications are used by dancers and callers everywhere, including the members of other square dance organizations.

CALLERLAB members are featured in nearly all of the calling slots at the National Square Dance Convention and conduct the caller training sessions at these same conventions.

CALLERLAB has established a Caller-Coach program to improve caller skills and thereby better serve dancers. CALLERLAB also provides a broad range of caller training sessions at its annual convention.

When BMI & ASCAP threatened clubs in the U.S. with license fees for every dance, CALLERLAB and ROUNDALAB working together, negotiated a new form of licensing so that dance leaders could take over this obligation from the clubs.

WPSRDF VISITATION PROGRAM

Guidelines

Visitation Year - The period during which countable visits can be made is from (and including) September 1st to August 31st. To be counted all visitation cards must have reached the Federation no later than two weeks prior to the WPSRDF Fall Festival.

Clubs Eligible to be Visited - Every WPSRDF member club that contributes \$30.00 to the visitations pool by the August WPSRDF meeting is eligible. Visits to clubs that did not contribute do not count. No contributions will be accepted after the August meeting. The Federation may add funds to the visitation pool if they choose to do so but this is not required.

List of Participating Clubs - By November 1st the Federation will provide each club's representative with the list of clubs that contributed. No other clubs will be eligible during that visitation year.

Eligible Visiting Clubs - Every WPSRDF member club is eligible to visit and to share proportionately in the visitation pool. (See definition of "Pool Sharing")

Eligible Dances - It is assumed a club's "regularly scheduled dances" are eligible to be visited. Higher level square and round dance clubs may, at their discretion, hold "open houses" to accommodate visitors. Also, it is entirely and unarguable the host club's decision whether a "Special Dance" can be visited or not. This must have been resolved before the visiting club's arrival. Put eligibility on the "Special Dance flyer."

Notifying the Host Club - As a courtesy, the club to be visited should be notified several days in advance of a visit that is planned and how many dancers to expect.

Ineligible Dances - Any Caller's Association or WPSRDF sponsored dances (such as the Fall Festival, Sophomore Dance etc.) are automatically ineligible, regardless of their being hosted by a specific club.

Eligible Visitors - Dancers eligible to represent a club are its current members. Also eligible are its students if the visit is to a class level dance. In every case, the dancer should wear the visiting club's regular or class badge and must sign in as representing the visiting club.

Free Passes - A visitor, to be counted, must pay the full admission fee. Dancers using free passes are not counted.

Dual Memberships - If a dancer belongs to both the club doing the visiting and the club being visited, the dancer must pay the full (or visitor) admission fee to be counted as a visitor.

Countable Visits - Although clubs are encouraged to visit as often as they like, no more than one visit to each club, in the program, will be recognized in any one year until all clubs have been visited. After each eligible club has been visited once (that completes one full round), additional full rounds may be completed. There is no limit to the number of consecutive full rounds that may be completed. Excess visits cannot be carried over to another year.

Pool Sharing - Visits made will share equally in the pool. In September, the total visits made by all clubs before September 1st will be calculated, and the pool will be divided by the number of visits, to determine the "value" of each visit. The minimum number of dancers for a two point visit is a full square of 8 dancers. Less than a full square (4-7 dancers) will count as a one point visit for calculating shared monies.

Plaque winners - "Most Visitors Plaque" - the club with the highest total number of dancers (visitors) visiting other clubs will hold the "Most Visitors Plaque" until the next Fall Festival. Ties will share recognition and the "Most Visitors Plaque." "Most Visits Plaque" - The club with the highest total number of visits to other clubs will hold the "Most Visits Plaque." Ties will share recognition and the "Most Visits Plaque."

Friendship Dangles - Dancers who participate in five or more visits for one club during the visitation year will receive a Friendship Dangle, provided by the Federation.

The participating clubs will benefit by added monies by having added dancers.
A visitation scoreboard will be posted in the West Pen News.
A progress report will be given at the Federation meeting.

Old Business

Pennsylvania Fabulous Fall Festival Pete Wex

There was a large concern about a month ago with the Coronavirus and its effect on meetings and groups. Pete and Bob Lawn talked to the manager at Radisson about our festival and the possibility of modifying the contract. The big concern was meeting the 300 room nights. The hotel was unwilling, at that time to cancel, without significant penalty. (\$20,000)

The local person (Amanda Shomper) was going to go to their corporate person for further guidance, but didn't sound very hopeful. However, if this emergency continues we could be in trouble, but also if continues we could invoke the Acts of God clause to get out of the contract closer to the September date. If it clears up we will probably have a very large crowd of people anxious to dance to some great callers.

What we received was a cancellation letter showing they are cancelling the reservation and waiving any cancellation fees. (which could have amounted to \$20,000). In her reply, Amanda Shomper the Director of Group Sales "We hope this shows our appreciation of your business and willingness to work with your group. We look forward to having you back in 2021. Thank you!"

It appears they are not interested in dragging this out until late summer. We believe they would prefer to have a commitment from a group (if they can find one) that would not have the closeness/touching concerns that we have. I also think they recognized they would have no defense against the Force Majeure/Act of God clause closer to the actual Fest date, and they'd be left with too little time to find something else. They could very well have come up empty that weekend anyway. Better for them to start trying to fill it with something else right now and keep open an amicable relationship with us that could last years if they cut us the break this time.

From our perspective, we don't think waiting to see what transpires these next few months is a viable option. That was made clear this past weekend with the extension of the social distancing precautions and predictions of 200,000 deaths. Promoting now will have been wasted time and effort if we did have to cancel later. Everyone (staff, committee, dancers, hotel) will have been kept in limbo. Even if we then could hold it, we are very much afraid that the number of dancers willing to chance it could be so small that we would take a huge hit on the callers'/cuers' compensations alone.

Bob Lawn and Pete Wex recommend that we make it officially known that it is being cancelled this year, both because of too much uncertainty and our unwillingness to put a watered down product out there (the program's quality was the key to its success last year, and that quality has to be maintained to keep its credibility and appeal).

At the PSRDF meeting, it was determined unanimously that we should cancel for 2020.

We then discussed **paying something to the Three (3) National Callers who depend only on square dancing for their livelihood.** This seems to be the procedure being followed by our large festivals that have cancelled due to the virus. After some discussion a motion was made to pay the callers \$500 and offer an incentive of additional \$500 if they sign a contract for 2021. We do recognize that some caller's may already have obligations. It was seconded. **Knowing that the treasury could afford this amount, it passed unanimously.**

So, 2020's committee will:

Check with the Radisson on a date for next year(Sept 23-26, 2021) if available. Pete doubled checked and these dates are available for 2021.

Notify the 3 National caller's and provide payment of \$500 and an added \$500 for returning a signed contract for 2021.

Notify any dancers currently registrated to roll-over registration, donate registration or provide an option to ask for a refund as well as having the dancer notifying the hotel to cancel rooms.

For 2020, Swing Thru's were working with Pete Wex to coordinate this event. Pete Wex said he would only work as a consultant for 2021. Swing Thru's will check to see if there is an interest in continuing for 2021 at a Board Meeting in May and let Clyde Miles know if they are willing to continue.

If not, then Clyde will be looking for volunteer leadership and club to pick up responsibility for 2021. So, if you might consider doing this.....

2020's committee recommend inviting everyone scheduled on this year's calling/cueing staff to be invited to be next years. Hopefully they will understand and empathize with the whole situation. The next leadership group should be established: chairperson(s), host club, various committees, etc. Pete is willing to act purely as a consultant in the future, sharing any observations, experience, suggestions gleaned from these first two efforts, but that will be the extent of his involvement.

Thanks to Bob Lawn and Pete Wex and their committee for all the hard work. These are difficult times with difficult decisions to be made. We hope square dancing will survive.

New Business

Incentive Program Clyde Miles

New dancer incentive program will continue. Any graduating dancers in 2020, must become members in 2021 to qualify. Ted Rotwitt asked about Perky Promenders' check. Clyde, Joe and Bob are aware of and working on this.

Any Other New Business?

In addition to the Pennsylvania Fall Festival scheduled for September 25-27, 2020 being cancelled.

The following have been cancelled:

National Convention in Washington State in June.

Ohio Convention early May.

Star Spangled Banner in July/Gettysburg.

Virginia in May.

WASCA cancelled in March.

At this time West Virginia is still planning their convention. It is scheduled for July 24-26, 2020. I will attach a copy of the details below.

Next meeting is Sunday October 4th at 1 p.m. Once again it is a teleconference.
